You'll find Opel-Zoo between Kronberg and Königstein, surrounded by the delightful uplands of the Anterior Taunus region. We're home to approximately 1700 animals representing more than 200 species – predominantly from Africa, Asia and Europe and many of which are endangered. Giraffes, zebras, meerkats, red pandas, cheetahs, kangaroos, African penguins, ring-tailed lemurs and many other animals share our zoo with Hessen's only elephants.

The animals at Opel-Zoo live in their social groups in habitats that are designed to replicate nature as closely as possible, with visible boundaries between humans and animals kept to an absolute minimum. Visitors can follow paths and informative trails around the 27 hectares of the zoo's grounds for unimpeded views into the diverse, elaborately laid out habitats to experience the animals in a way second only to observing them in nature itself.

Special attractions include the expansive African savanna enclosure, the elephant park and the spacious habitat for African penguins, as well as the Madagascar primate house for ring-tailed and red-ruffed lemurs which was inaugurated in 2021. Our next big construction project is the Asia exhibit, which will be home to Indian rhinoceroses as well as other species.
